

COUNCIL MEETING OF NOVEMBER 19, 2007

The second regular November meeting of the Mannington City Council with Mayor Frank White presiding was held Monday, November 19, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. at city hall. Council members attending were Bob Garcia, Robbie Ice, Betty Liller, Terry Starsick and Del Watson.

Jeannie Brenneman and Jim Chadwell from the Marion County United Way gave a brief outline of their organization and said they are currently funding twenty agencies. Chadwell said their goal this year is \$325,000. He said they would love a donation from the city plus would like to implement a workplace campaign. Fluharty asked if they had info to include in the employees' payroll checks. Brenneman said to contact Acting Director Leisha Elliott for literature.

In his report, Mayor White said that County Assessor Jim Priester has been invited to attend the next council meeting to discuss the upcoming reappraisal in Mannington. An article will be put in the newspaper inviting citizens to attend.

The mayor read the written Street/Water Department report.

Under old business, White noted that Martin Repair has been given the go ahead on the Marshall Street wall repair.

The first item under new business was another appointment to the Mannington Middle School Task Force. Mayor White recommended that Patricia Kruza be appointed. Starsick made the motion to accept the mayor's recommendation and appoint Kruza to the task force. Garcia seconded the motion and all approved.

The final item of business was Christmas bonuses for the city employees. Liller made the motion to grant bonuses of \$250 to the full time employees and \$150 to the part time employees. Starsick seconded the motion and it carried.

Garcia made the motion to adjourn. Ice seconded the motion and it carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
