

# CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF JUNE 6, 2011

The first regular June meeting of the Mannington City Council with Mayor Bob Garcia presiding was held Monday, June 6, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. Council members in attendance were Jeff Michael, Harry Moore, Larry Smith, and Terry Starsick.

City Clerk Michele Fluharty read the minutes of the last regular meeting and they stood approved as read.

In the visitors' portion of the meeting, City Patrolman Andy Kolb asked about the plans for the police department since Chief of Police David James is off on medical leave. Mayor Garcia said nothing has been finalized yet but he is working with Sgt. Liller to set a new schedule.

In department reports, Street & Water Superintendent Ted Nice gave his report. Councilman Starsick said the downtown clock is not running and asked that it be checked. Nice was reminded that new street signs were needed for Tannery and Cemetery Streets.

Councilman Smith said he had received a request for a dusk to dawn light on Railroad Street. Garcia said he would check on it.

Fluharty said council must meet to canvass the votes from tomorrow's election on Monday, June 13 and asked what time was good for everyone. It was agreed to meet at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Garcia asked for council's approval of two grant applications through the WV DEP. The litter control grant would help pay the expenses for the spring and fall clean-up days. The recycling grant would go toward establishing a recycling center and education of the public to use the center. Moore made the motion to approve the application for the Litter Control Grant. Michael seconded the motion and it carried.

The final General fund budget revision was tabled until the next meeting.

Mayor Garcia asked for an executive session to discuss two personnel matters. Starsick made the motion to go into executive session. Michael seconded the motion and it carried. The time was 7:15 p.m.

The regular meeting reconvened at 7:28 p.m.

Mayor Garcia asked for a motion to table the final two items on the agenda. Moore made the motion to table Ordinance #400 and the decision on PEIA coverage. Starsick seconded the motion and all approved.

Starsick made the motion to adjourn. Moore seconded the motion and it carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
