

CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF MAY 2, 2011

The first regular May meeting of the Mannington City Council with Mayor Bob Garcia presiding was held Monday, May 2, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. at city hall. Council members in attendance were Jeff Michael, Harry Moore and Larry Smith.

City Clerk Michele Fluharty read the minutes of the last regular meeting and they stood approved as read.

In the visitors' portion of the meeting, Larry Efaw said there are many pot holes on Windy Hill Drive. Mayor Garcia told him that they will be patched as soon as the plant is back on line and the rain stops.

In department reports, Assistant Superintendent Ted Nice gave a report on their activities during the last week. He noted that they have tested 297 meters but have 700 left to do.

There was no old business.

The first item under new business was General Fund budget revision #5 which appropriates more money for asphalt. Michael made the motion to approve the General Fund budget revision. Moore seconded the motion and it carried.

Mayor Garcia said the insurance claim check for the Chevy Blazer cruiser has not arrived yet and D & D Refinishing would like paid for the repair work. He asked for authorization to advance the payment to D & D. Michael made the motion to approve the payment to D & D Refinishing with the understanding that the insurance check will be deposited into General Fund when it is received. Moore seconded the motion and it carried. Garcia said the accident occurred when another driver backed into the cruiser while it was parked at the Rainbow Plaza.

Moore made the motion to adjourn. Michael seconded the motion and it carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
