

## COUNCIL MEETING OF FEBRUARY 1, 2010

The first regular February meeting of the Mannington City Council with Mayor Bob Garcia presiding was held Monday, February 1, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. Council members attending were Jeff Michael, Harry Moore, Larry Smith, Terry Starsick and Rana Taylor.

City Clerk Michele Fluharty read the minutes of the last regular meeting and they stood approved as read.

Sheena Hunt of Region Six presented Pay Requisition #31 for the Fairmont/Mannington Water Project. Moore made the motion to approve Pay Requisition #31 in the amount of \$4,493.85. Starsick seconded the motion and it carried. Hunt said there is \$120,668.29 left in the city's portion of the grant. She added that Randy Watson is checking on prices for some of the eligible costs being considered for the balance of the city's funds.

The mayor read the Street/Water Department report. Smith asked if anything had been done about the parking on Pleasant Street. Garcia said Duda Cable's trucks are there on a temporary basis and once they leave, the situation should be corrected.

In new business, the water agreement with Mannington Public Service District was the first item on the agenda. The city attorney recommendation to add another paragraph to the agreement was reviewed. Moore made the motion to approve the agreement with the attorney's addition. Taylor seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Garcia said, upon request, he has designated February as Boy Scout month in the City.

Starsick asked about the traffic study for Route 250. Garcia said he has not had any luck with the DOT but he is still trying. Starsick also said the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Committee should be meeting soon. Garcia said he plans to set up a meeting in the next couple of weeks.

A budget meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 16.

Moore made the motion to adjourn. Starsick seconded the motion and it carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
