

## COUNCIL MEETING OF JANUARY 3, 2012

The first regular January meeting of the Mannington City Council with Mayor Bob Garcia presiding was held Tuesday, January 3, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. at city hall. Council members attending were Christina Dunigan, Larry Smith, Terry Starsick and Becky Williams.

City Clerk Michele Fluharty read the minutes of the last regular meeting. Dunigan made the motion to accept the minutes as read. Williams seconded the motion and it carried.

In department reports, Fluharty said the audit has been rescheduled for the end of January, at the request of Tetrick & Bartlett.

There was no old business.

In new business, the only item was General Fund Budget revision #3. Fluharty said the revision was necessary primarily because the Police Department's salaries have gone over budget due to two officers being in the academy and the chief being on medical leave. Starsick made the motion to approve the revisions as presented. Smith seconded the motion and it carried.

Starsick asked if work has been started on the Route 250 drainage problem by Carnes' Auto. Mayor Garcia said he has not been able to reach Roncone at the State DOT yet.

Starsick made the motion to adjourn. Dunigan seconded the motion and all approved. The meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
