

COUNCIL MEETING OF JUNE 16, 2014

The second regular June meeting of the Mannington City Council with Mayor Jim Taylor presiding was held Monday, June 16, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at city hall. Council members attending were Charlie Kolb, Larry Smith, Terry Starsick, Richard Stevens and Becky Williams.

City Clerk Michele Fluharty read the minutes of the last regular meeting and they stood approved as read.

There was no Old Business.

In New Business, Kristin Wilson's request for sponsorship of her trip to the Ms United States pageant representing West Virginia was the first item on the agenda. Starsick made the motion to donate \$200 from the Mead Fund to Wilson. Stevens seconded the motion and it carried.

Taylor recommended that Denny Efaw be appointed to fill the unexpired term on the Building Commission. Kolb made the motion to appoint Efaw. Stevens seconded the motion and it carried. His term will expire on June 30, 2014.

The DOH report on the inspection of the Northview Bridge was discussed. Mayor Taylor said the recommendation was to remove the bridge and he is currently getting quotes for its demolition. He said his only concern is the school bus pick-up for the kids in Northview. He plans to talk to Superintendent Gary Price about the matter. Taylor said there is money in the General Fund to pay for the bridge's removal.

The final General Fund budget revision for FY 2013-14 was reviewed. Kolb made the motion to approve the revisions as presented. Stevens seconded the motion and it carried.

The outstanding bills were approved in a motion by Stevens. Smith seconded the motion and it carried.

Taylor updated council on a few outstanding matters. He said the trailhead bathroom has been repaired and it is now open. He also noted that a sump pump is being purchased to alleviate the water problem behind Signs & More. He plans to approach Robin & Ed Smith to see if they will pay for the electric service to the pump and in exchange the City will haul dirt and cover the drain line. Taylor said he also advised them that there is to be no more unapproved fill dumped on their property. Smith asked if he talked to the Donato's about fill too and Taylor said he did not because he wasn't aware they were placing fill there. Taylor said the Mannington Gym Foundation is having seamless gutters and downspouts put on the gymnasium this week.

Kolb said the Park Board may need some help before the All-Class Reunion in July. Taylor told him just to call.

Starsick made the motion to adjourn. Stevens seconded the motion and it carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
