

## **COUNCIL MEETING OF DECEMBER 1, 2014**

The first regular monthly meeting of the Mannington City Council with Mayor James Taylor presiding was held Monday, December 1, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at city hall. Council members attending were Charlie Kolb, Terry Starsick and Becky Williams.

City Clerk Michele Fluharty read the minutes of the last meeting and they stood approved as read.

There were no visitors.

In department reports, Street & Water Superintendent Ted Nice said the Christmas lights are all up. He added that a breaker had blown on the downtown lights which caused them to go out. Nice said V & W Electric has LED bulbs for the downtown lights and he is going to try a couple to see if they are bright enough. Taylor thanked Jean Efaw for donating this year's Christmas tree from their tree farm in honor of her late husband, Bill.

The first item under Old Business was the second and final reading of Ordinance #416 which regulates truck traffic on Water Street. Williams made the motion to read the heading only. Kolb seconded the motion and it carried. Taylor read the heading. Kolb made the motion to adopt Ordinance #416. Starsick seconded the motion and it carried.

In New Business, Taylor reported that the contract for the Clarksburg Street Bridge Project has been awarded to the Ohio Bridge Corporation and it is slated to start in late February or early March. He said there will be a meeting with the WV DOT to set an alternate route while the bridge is being replaced and he will notify the council members so they can attend.

The outstanding bills were reviewed. Starsick made the motion to approve payment of the bills as presented. Kolb seconded the motion and it carried.

Starsick made the motion to adjourn. Williams seconded the motion and it carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
