

COUNCIL MEETING OF APRIL 20, 2009

The second regular April meeting of the Mannington City Council with Councilman at Large Robert Garcia presiding in the absence of Mayor White was held Monday, April 20, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. Council members in attendance were Betty Liller, Harold Rosencrance, Terry Starsick and Del Watson.

City Clerk Michele Fluharty read the minutes of the last regular meeting and they stood approved as read.

Sheena Hunt of Region Six PDC presented Pay Requisition #26 for the ongoing Fairmont/Mannington water project in the amount of \$58,057.59. Starsick made the motion to approve Requisition # 26 for payment. Liller seconded the motion and it carried on a 3-2. Garcia and Watson voted no.

Becka Efaw thanked the city for the Children Playing sign that was recently put up on Meadow Avenue.

Roger Russell reported on a sealed drain by the First Baptist Church which is causing water to back up and erode their sidewalk. Street/Water Superintendent Charlie Rexrode is to check on the drain.

In department reports, Garcia read the Street/Water Department report.

Under new business, the first item of business was the Casey Ryan monument for Hough Park. The Ryan family met with council at the April 6th work session and presented plans for the monument. Rosencrance made the motion to approve the monument as presented by the Ryan family. Starsick seconded the motion and all approved.

At the last council meeting, Mayor White asked Rexrode to look over the trailer for sale by Ed Smith in Homewood to see if it would meet his department's needs. Rexrode has recommended the purchase of the trailer. Starsick asked what the trailer would be used for and Rexrode said it would transport the roller that is going to be rented from Rob Yost. Liller made the motion to authorize the purchase of the trailer for \$1,400. Watson seconded the motion and it carried.

The Hach service agreement for the turbidity meter has expired and Chief Operator Ted Nice has recommended that it not be renewed since the plant should be shut down in June when the city goes on line with Fairmont. Starsick made the motion to accept Nice's recommendation to not renew the agreement. Liller seconded the motion and it carried.

Garcia reminded everyone of the levy meeting tomorrow at 6:00 p.m.

Watson made the motion to adjourn. Rosencrance seconded the motion and it carried. The meeting will stand adjourned until tomorrow evening's levy meeting.
