

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING UPON PROPOSED ORDINANCE**

**TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:**

Mannington City Council at a regular meeting held January 17, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. at city hall introduced and read for the first time a proposed ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FLOODPLAIN AREA AND REQUIRING ALL CONTRACTORS, PERSONS, PARTNERSHIPS, BUSINESSES AND CORPORATIONS TO OBTAIN A PERMIT FOR DEVELOPMENT AND THE CONSTRUCTION, SUBSTANTIAL IMPROVEMENT OR RELOCATION OF ANY BUILDING OR STRUCTURE; PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR CONSTRUCTION WITHIN THE FLOODPLAIN AREA AND SETTING FORTH SPECIAL PROCEDURES FOR SUBMISSION AND APPROVAL OF PLANS; AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR ANY PERSON WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OR PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE. A public hearing will be held on Monday, February 6, 2012 during the regular council meeting which begins at 7:00 p.m. in the council chambers at City Hall, 206 Main Street, Mannington, WV. All parties and interests may appear at said public hearing and be heard as to whether or not this proposed ordinance shall be enacted. After all objections and suggestions are heard, City Council shall take such action as it deems proper. Non-English speaking persons who wish to attend should contact the City so that proper accommodations can be made. A TDD is available for the hearing impaired. Copies of the proposed ordinance are on file in the City Clerk's Office at city hall for public inspection between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. weekdays.
