

## SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING OF JUNE 10, 2013

A special meeting of the Mannington City Council with Mayor Bob Garcia presiding was held Monday, June 10, 2013 at 6:30 p.m. Council members attending were Christina Dunigan, Larry Smith, Terry Starsick, Rana Taylor and Becky Williams. Also attending was City Clerk Michele Fluharty and Attorney Tamara DeFazio.

Mayor Garcia asked to adjourn into executive session to discuss a personnel matter. Dunigan made the motion to adjourn into executive session at 6:30 p.m. Taylor seconded the motion and it carried.

Starsick made the motion to reconvene into regular session at 6:55 p.m. Dunigan seconded the motion and it carried.

Starsick made the motion to accept the mediated insurance settlement, along with all of its stipulations, as devised on June 5, 2013. Taylor seconded the motion and all approved.

Council then acting as the Board of Canvassers began canvassing the votes for the June 4, 2013 election. All four precincts were canvassed and the voted, provisional, spoiled and unused ballots were all accounted for and recorded. The four provisional ballots were then considered. Smith made the motion to remove the challenges to provisional ballots in Precincts #66, #67 & #68 when the voters' names were found in another registration book. Dunigan seconded the motion and all approved. One challenge in Precinct #68 was upheld when the voter's name could not be found. Those ballots were then opened. Garcia picked up three votes, Kolb one, Haught one and Starsick one.
